## SINCE AUGUST 2010, WE HAVE:

- ▶ Supported approximately 3,000 registered Dragonflies
- ▶ Grown to serve 3 hospitals: Cincinnati Children's Hospital and Dayton Children's Hospital in Ohio, and the Ann & Robert H. Lurie Children's Hospital in Chicago, IL
- ▶ Reinvested more than \$5 Million into the Greater Cincinnati community
- ▶ Raised awareness about the importance of emotional care and quality of life
- ▶ Built a growing community of support for Dragonflies and their families
- ▶ Minimized the psychological pain and fear young patients experience with hair loss as a result of chemotherapy
- ▶ Educated supporters about the immediate and long-term emotional, physical, and financial challenges associated with cancer and bone marrow transplants
- ▶ Partnered with related organizations, including Ronald McDonald House of Cincinnati, Hoxworth Blood Center, Be The Match, and others
